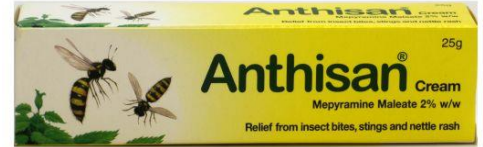


Forest School Consent – Medical

Forest school sessions take place in the natural environment. Although suitable personal protective equipment will be used, there is always a small risk of a child accidentally touching a stinging nettle or coming into contact with a bee or wasp. In order to provide immediate relief for your child, we will carry Anthisan, an antihistamine cream.
