What we will be learning this year

During this year we have three main topics that we will base our humanities learning:

In the autumn term our theme is 'Movers and

Shakers'. We will learn about historically significant people who have had a major impact on the world. We will learn to use timelines, stories and historical sources to find out about the people featured and use historical models to explore their significance.



Moving into the Spring term we turn our attention to the natural world. We'll learn all about the parts of a plant and have opportunities to observe our own seeds as they grow. We'll find out

about animal habitats, food chains and life cycles along the way.

Finally, in the Summer term we will explore the UK Coastline. We will learn about the physical and human features of the coastline including a detailed exploration of the coastal

town of Whitby in Yorkshire.

Maths

Before starting Year 2, it is expected that children will know their number bonds to 10. If they are confident, they should begin linking this to bonds to 20.

In Year 2, Children will be expected to demonstrate a strong understanding of place value, being able to identify the tens and ones of a two-digit number.

Children should be accessing Numbots or Times Tables Rock Stars at home several times a week to reinforce their fluency with number.

Reading

Reading in Year 2 takes the form of:

- Shared class book read daily
- Daily RWI Phonics or reading comprehension lessons (dependent on stage)
- Children visit the library every week and choose a reading book to share.

Home reading books are changed once a week. Children are expected to read at home a minimum of three times a week to build their fluency and develop comprehension skills. Please record any feedback in your child's reading record.

Our Forest school day is

Tuesday mornings

(children attend on alternate weeks)

Children attending Forest School can arrive at school in their forest school clothing on Tuesdays, but must bring uniform to change in to for the afternoon. Don't forget socks!
