In the autumn term we will learn about t the




characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the

### **Maths**

By Year 4 every child should know and be able to rapidly recall all their time tables up to the 12-time table.

During June all children will take part in the National Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This is an, online, statutory assessment consisting of 25 questions randomly selected from the 2-12 times tables.

If your child is already fluent with their times table, practising their division facts will help them as we start to look at fractions this year.

# Reading

Reading in Year 4 takes the form of:

- Shared class book that is read every day
- Daily reading comprehension lessons
- Children visit the library every Tuesday and choose a 'free reader' reading book

Children receiving reading interventions will continue to have a levelled book sent home to support their reading fluency.
