What we will be learning this year

During this year we have three main topics that we will base our humanities learning on:

In the autumn term we will learn about **'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles'**. We will investigate the structure of the earth, types of rocks, fossils, volcanoes, earthquakes and Tsunamis.





Moving into the Spring term we turn our attention to **'Emperors and Empires'**. We will explore the founding of Rome, emperors, ancient Rome, moving onto Romans in Britain through chronological understanding and research.



Finally, in the Summer term we will look back **'Through the Ages'**, examining the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age through everyday life, tools and weapons, settlements and beliefs. We will also investigate definitions of time and learn about archaeologists.





Maths

In Year 3 children will continue to practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables they learnt in Year 2, they will also learn 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Children should be accessing Times Tables Rock Stars at home throughout the week to build their fluency with number.

The year focus is to ensure that children become increasingly fluent with whole numbers and the four operations as we continue to build on place value learning.

Reading

Reading in Year 3 takes the form of:

- Shared class book that is read every day
- Daily reading comprehension lessons
- Children visit the library every week and choose a reading book to share.

Home reading books are changed once a week. Children are expected to read at home a minimum of three times a week to build their fluency and develop comprehension skills. Please record any feedback in your child's reading record.
