The performance will take place on **Monday 20th May** at the Derngate theatre. Tickets are already available to buy, these sell out quickly so if you are planning to come and watch your child, please book via the theatre website or contact the ticket office.

On the day of the performance, there will be a rehearsal for all performers together, at the Derngate, Northampton. This rehearsal will start at approx. 2.00pm and students will need to bring a packed tea to eat before the performance begins at 6.00pm. Details will be sent nearer the time.

We have already started rehearsing the songs in choir. If your child wishes to join the Big Sing event, they will need to attend choir rehearsals after school on Thursday. There is also a charge of £5 per pupil to cover the registration fees for the event. (Only for KS2 choir members who take part in the BIG SING event in May).









We are also looking forward to a member of NMPAT coming into school to lead a singing workshop to help us learn all the songs.

This really is a wonderful opportunity to sing with hundreds of other children in a professionally organised event at Royal & Derngate, the main venue for arts and entertainment in Northamptonshire.
